

## FIRST GRADE

- School Backpack (with handle and wheels)
  - 1 Lunch box (no paper bags)
  - 2 composition notebooks (wide ruled)
  - 4 plastic folders (green, blue, red, yellow)
  - 1 12" ruler
  - 5 sharpened pencils (no mechanical pencils)
  - 2 erasers
  - 1 sharpener
  - 2 highlighters (green and yellow)
  - 1 pair of scissors (5" children's rounded Fiskars. Please be advised, there are left-handed scissors)
  - 1 pencil pouch (no pencil boxes)
  - 16 glue sticks
  - 1 pack of dry eraser markers
  - 4 boxes of "Crayola" crayons (not scented or glitter)
  - 4 boxes of washable "Crayola" markers
  - 1 "five subjects" notebook
